

All Ambassador Meeting Agenda Recognition & Celebration

Opening Welcome (5 – 10 minutes)

Warm, fun welcome to the whole group- consider music and food to welcome Ambassadors as they enter the meeting space.

Upstander Box/Locker of Questions/Concerns

Have a box where students can drop questions, concerns, and suggestions at any time.

"Strength Circle" Activity

To begin, each student will need his/her own envelope with a blank piece of paper inside. Instruct each student to write their name on the outside of their envelope and then gather together to sit in a circle. Once in a circle, everyone will pass their envelope to the person on their right. With each passing of the envelope students will take the piece of paper out of the envelope and write down a strength they recognize in their peer. Encourage students to write about a specific time they noticed each person's strength!

National Outreach/Summer Project!

Have students research current events then write letters of support to victims of mistreatment, or to families that have lost someone due to mistreatment.

Closing Activity

Ask each person to think about a personal goal that they have for themselves as an Ambassador for the next year. Go around and have each person finish these two sentences:

- * "Something my past self would tell me now is..."
- * "Something my future self would tell me now is...."

Exit

As each student exits, shake his/her hand and give him or her an Ambassador certificate of recognition. Certificates can be found in Program Tools > Year End Wrap Up
